



McGregor Boulevard Roadway and Drainage Improvements Project
Construction Update Week of September 5, 2017

The City of Fort Myers is replacing storm drainage on McGregor Boulevard from Colonial Boulevard to Poinciana Avenue. In addition to replacing the existing pipes, the project will resurface the roadway, replace sidewalk where disturbed by pipe replacement, replace some signage, and update crosswalks with new striping and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accommodations. The final product will not change the “look” of McGregor Boulevard as it is today. The speed limit on McGregor Boulevard has been temporarily reduced to 25 mph in the work zone.

McGregor Boulevard

- **Beginning at 7 a.m., Tuesday, September 5 through 6 p.m., Friday, September 15, 2017, MCGREGOR BOULEVARD IS CLOSED FROM MORENO AVENUE TO OLMEDA WAY NORTHBOUND AND CALOOSA DRIVE TO GASPARILLA DRIVE SOUTHBOUND. TRAFFIC IS DETOURED** as follows:
 - Northbound – Olmeda Way to Via Torcida to Rosada Way to Cortez Boulevard to Moreno Avenue to McGregor Boulevard.
 - Southbound – Caloosa Drive to Avocado Drive to Gasparilla Drive to McGregor Boulevard.
 - East side streets of McGregor Boulevard - Grace Avenue, Passaic Avenue, Ricardo Avenue, Maravilla Avenue, Rosada Way, and Paloma Drive will all be closed at McGregor Boulevard. Please use alternate routes to access McGregor Boulevard.
 - West side streets of McGregor Boulevard - Bougainvillea Street, Osceola Drive, Hanton Avenue, Plumosa Drive, and Florida Avenue will all be closed at McGregor Boulevard. Please use alternate routes to access McGregor Boulevard.
 - This detour will remain in place during daytime and nighttime/overnight hours until work is completed.
- Motorists should expect traffic shifts on McGregor Boulevard from Poinciana Avenue to Colonial Boulevard.
- Motorists should expect one lane open to traffic from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Saturday. Flaggers will maintain both directions of travel.

Some sidewalks may be closed within the project area and pedestrians and bicyclists may be detoured. **This schedule may be subject to change due to inclement weather and unforeseen underground conditions.** Drivers, bicyclists and pedestrians should use caution.
