



McGregor Boulevard Roadway and Drainage Improvements Project

Roadwatch for week of April 23, 2017

The City of Fort Myers is replacing storm drainage on McGregor Boulevard from Colonial Boulevard to Poinciana Avenue. In addition to replacing the existing pipes, the project will resurface the roadway, replace sidewalk where disturbed by pipe replacement, replace some signage, and update crosswalks with new striping and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accommodations. The final product will not change the “look” of McGregor Boulevard as it is today.

- **Motorists should expect Winkler Avenue closed at McGregor Boulevard from 9 a.m., Wednesday, April 19 to 5 p.m. Thursday, April 20 (including overnight) for crews to complete underground work.**
- **Motorists should expect Hill Avenue closed from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Friday, April 21 and Monday, April 24 for crews to complete underground work.**
- **Motorists should expect Roosevelt Avenue closed at McGregor Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday, April 24 through Wednesday, April 26.**
- **Motorists should expect Morningside Drive closed at McGregor Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Thursday, April 27 and Friday, April 28.**
- **Motorists should expect one lane open to traffic from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Saturday. Flaggers will maintain both directions of travel.**
- **Motorists should expect northbound McGregor Boulevard traffic shifted to the center lane from Meadowpark/Carleton Lane to Morningside Drive and from south of Hill Avenue to Ricardo Avenue.**

Some sidewalks may be closed within the project area and pedestrians and bicyclists may be detoured. This schedule may be subject to change due to inclement weather and unforeseen underground conditions. Drivers, bicyclists and pedestrians should use caution.
