



McGregor Boulevard Roadway and Drainage Improvements Project

Roadwatch for week of July 6, 2017

The City of Fort Myers is replacing storm drainage on McGregor Boulevard from Colonial Boulevard to Poinciana Avenue. In addition to replacing the existing pipes, the project will resurface the roadway, replace sidewalk where disturbed by pipe replacement, replace some signage, and update crosswalks with new striping and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accommodations. The final product will not change the “look” of McGregor Boulevard as it is today. The speed limit on McGregor Boulevard has been temporarily reduced to 25 mph in the work zone.

McGregor Boulevard

- **Beginning at 7 a.m., Monday, July 10 through Tuesday, August 1, NORTHBOUND MCGREGOR BOULEVARD TRAFFIC WILL BE DETOURED to Winkler Avenue to McKinley Avenue to Jefferson Avenue.** Southbound McGregor Boulevard traffic will use the northbound lanes to allow for crews to install storm drainage under the west side of the road.
- Motorists should expect one lane open to traffic from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Saturday. Flaggers will maintain both directions of travel.
- Motorists should expect traffic shifts on McGregor Boulevard from Poinciana Avenue to Colonial Boulevard.

McGregor Boulevard from south of McGregor Cafe to Terra Palma Drive

- Motorists should expect construction activities such as forming and pouring concrete curbs and restoring driveways on the east side of McGregor Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. **Residents should park on side streets while crews are restoring curb and driveways.**

Poinciana Avenue

- Motorists should expect Poinciana Avenue closed at McGregor Boulevard **through Friday, July 7** for crews to perform underground work.

Cordova Avenue

- Motorists should expect one lane of Cordova Avenue closed on the west side of McGregor Avenue **through 6 p.m. on Thursday, July 6** for crews to place limerock.

Alcazar Avenue

- Motorists should expect Alcazar Avenue closed on the west side of McGregor from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Thursday, July 6 and Friday, July 7** for crews to place limerock.

Caloosa Drive

- Motorists should expect Caloosa Drive closed at McGregor Boulevard **through Thursday, July 6** for crews to perform underground work.

Moreno Avenue

- Motorists should expect Moreno Avenue closed at McGregor Boulevard from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. through Thursday, July 13 (excluding the weekend)**.

Grace Avenue

- Motorists should expect Grace Avenue closed at McGregor Boulevard from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. through Thursday, July 13 (excluding the weekend)**.

Burtwood Drive, Stadler Drive and Morningside Drive

- Motorists should expect these streets closed at McGregor Boulevard from **Monday, July 10 through Tuesday, August 1**. Residents must use Harold Avenue to Vesper Drive or Sunbury Drive to access McGregor Boulevard.

Santa Barbara Avenue

- Motorists should expect Santa Barbara Avenue closed at McGregor Boulevard from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. through Monday, July 10 (excluding the weekend)** for crews to install curb.

Some sidewalks may be closed within the project area and pedestrians and bicyclists may be detoured. **This schedule may be subject to change due to inclement weather and unforeseen underground conditions.** Drivers, bicyclists and pedestrians should use caution.
